

Steps of the Vote-By-Mail **Process:**

All active registered voters are sent a voteby-mail ballot starting no later than 29 days before Election Day. Voters can be notified when their ballot is sent by signing up for Where's My Ballot? WheresMyBallot.sos.ca.gov

A voter marks their ballot, places it into the return envelope, and signs the return envelope. This signature will be verified by the county elections official after the return envelope is received.

**Ballot return envelopes** have pre-paid postage. They can be placed in the mail, placed in an official ballot drop box, or brought to any polling place in the state on or before **Election Day.** 

# **Postmarked By Election Day**

Signatures on ballot return envelopes are checked against voter registration records. If the signature is missing or does not compare to the voter's registration record, the voter will be contacted to resolve the issue.

## **Ballots Are Counted**

Starting at 8 pm on election night, reporting begins on vote-by-mail ballots received prior to Election Day and on ballots voted at polling locations. Ballots continue to be counted until certification.
